Dandy is the flagship brand of Wine for the People, Dandy Rosé is still and dry made from traditional Southern French varieties, while it's sparkling counterpart, Dandy Bubbles, has its own unique character and charm. Rae Wilson is one of the few female winemakers in the state of Texas.

2025 DANDY BUBBLES

Wine style: Bottle-fermented dry sparkling rosé

VARIETIES: Cinsaut 70%, Mourvedre 25%, Roussanne 5%

VINEYARDS: La Pradera Vineyard, Lost Draw Vineyard, Uplift Vineyard



Mostly sourced from the Texas High Plains AVA, which boasts high elevations between 3,000 and 4,000 ft. These grapes ripen during the day, and due to cool temperatures at night, have the time to rest and retain refreshing levels of acidity. Well-drained sandy soils allow for stellar concentration, and round overall balance.

2025 VINTAGE: Solid spring and summer rains gave the vines a healthy start to the season. Moderate temperatures and a dry harvest led to a long season and exceptional grape development.

TASTING NOTES

Bright, fresh, and medium-bodied, the aromas show white nectarine, melon, and white cherry, with plenty more to discover. A mineral-herbal undertone shows depth on the palate.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with garlic-driven dishes which will be tamed by fruitiness, and fresh or grilled seafood.



WINEMAKING: Pressed, fermented and aged separately in concrete, stainless steel,

and neutral oak barrel. Blended together and then bottled after roughly 6 months.

AGE OF VINES: 12 to 20 years

Serve at 49° F

SOIL TYPE: Primarily amarillo fine sandy loam over limestone base

Drink now to 2025

ELEVATION: Primarily 3,400 ft
