Dandy is the flagship brand of Wine for the People, Dandy Rosé is still and dry made from traditional Southern French varieties, while it's sparkling counterpart, Dandy Bubbles, has its own unique character and charm. Rae Wilson is one of the few female winemakers in the state of Texas.

2025 DANDY ROSÉ

Wine style: Still and dry pink wine from red grapes grown in Texas.

VARIETIES: 90% Mourvedre, 10% Cinsault

AVA: Texas High Plains



VINEYARD: La Pradera Vineyard

Established in 2010 by Mike and Barbara Paddock with the help of Texas grape-growers Andy and Lauren Timmons, who also currently manage the 120 acres. The different grape varieties are planted on a special soil combination that is calcareous, organic, sandyloam over limestone that is just 2-3 feet deep in some blocks. The wines are aromatic and fresh in style.

2025 VINTAGE: Solid spring and summer rains gave the vines a healthy start to the season. Moderate temperatures and a dry harvest led to a long season and exceptional grape development.

TASTING NOTES

Boisterous aromas of red berries and rosehip, mandarin, and mineral. The palate is nearly bone dry with chalky acidity that soars through the crunchy fruitiness! Medium-bodied.

FOOD PAIRING



Pair with coconut shrimp, tropical ceviche, charcuterie, and even shish kabobs!



WINEMAKING: Fermented in stainless steel tank.

Aged separately in stainless steel tank for 6 months before blending and bottling.

AGE OF VINES: 14 years

Serve at 45° F

SOIL TYPE: Amarillo fine sandy loam over limestone base
